

How to update antivirus from *local folder* in Kaspersky Internet Security 6.0 and 7.0?

Concerning to:

- Kaspersky Internet Security 6.0 MP2
- Kaspersky Internet Security 7.0

You Can save Antivirus updates in Local folder.

Create a Local Folder "Update" in any partion you want.

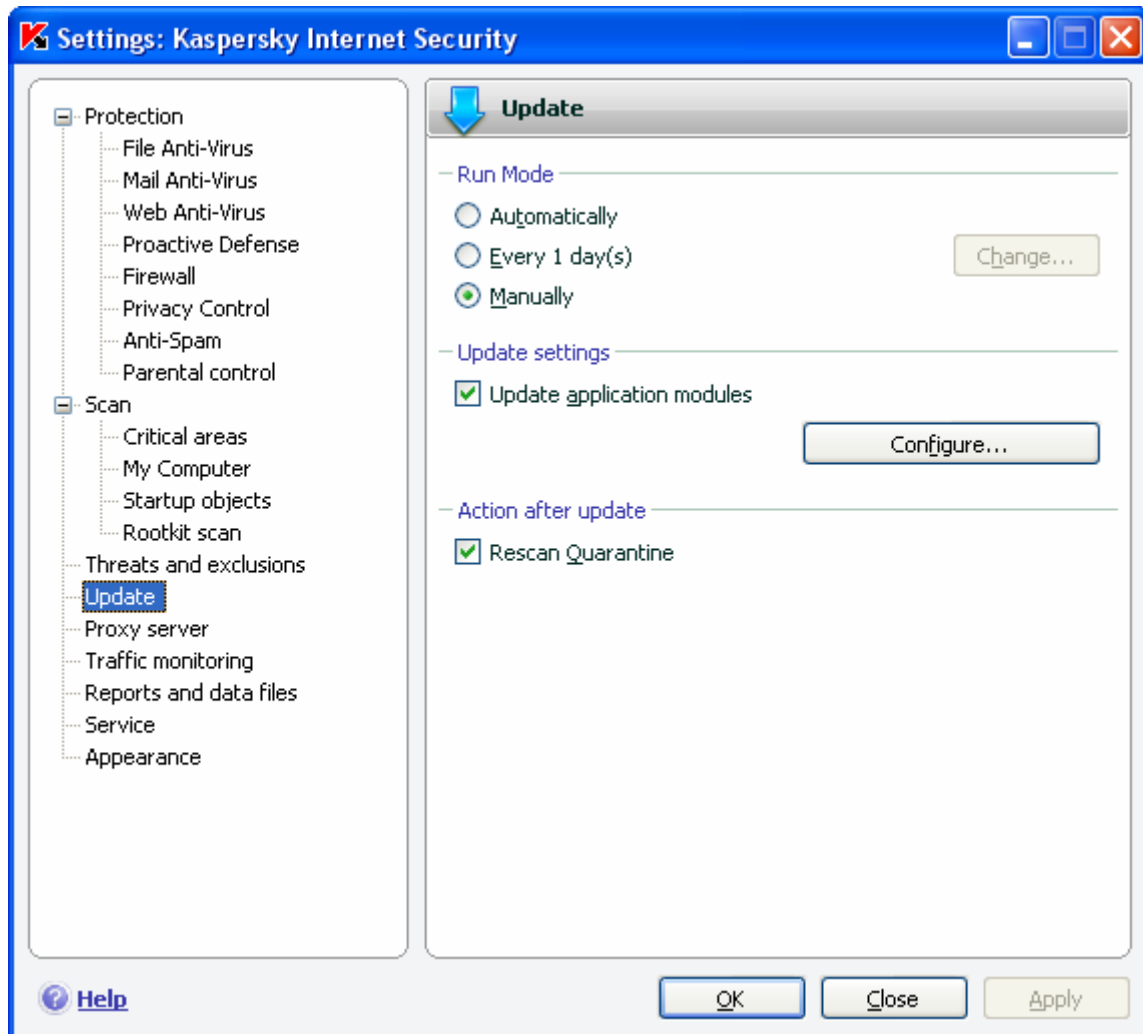
ex. D:\update

Double Click on Kaspersky Antivirus icon on windows Taskbar (Right-bottom of Screen)

Click on [Setting](#) Tab



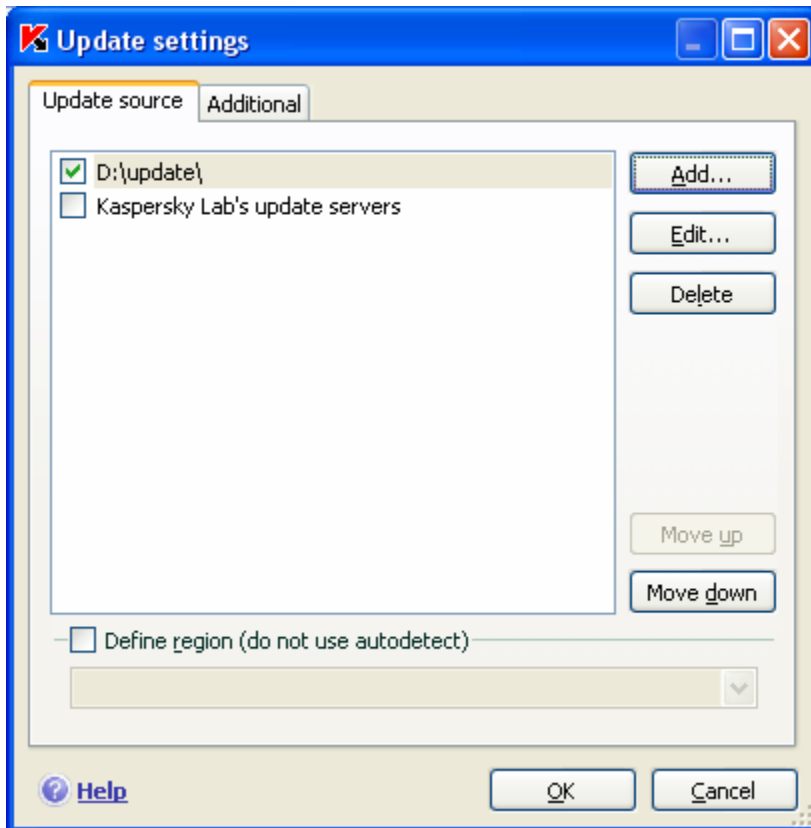
Click on [Update](#) option and then click on [Configure](#) Button



Click on [Update source](#) and [disable](#) Kaspersky Lab's update servers

Click on [Add](#) button and browse the [folder](#) (where you already saved updates) from where you want to Update

ex. D:\update



Now Click on [Update](#) button and click on [Update Databases](#)
